

# NEW BOTTLE RENEWED TASTE

#### THE NR 1 SHAPED BOTTLE

The S72 Gin 'the Legend' has been an established value in the world of gin since 2017. Six years later, the delicacy that sprang from the brain of ten-time world motocross champion Stefan Everts gets a completely new look: a bottle in the shape of the number 1.

Stefan Everts had been toying with the idea of a new, striking bottle for some time. The ball really started rolling when he sat down with designer Troy Lee. The ten-time world champion. who had already worked with the designer in his career as a motocross racer. asked the American to design a new bottle. Trov Lee came up with the idea of a bottle in the shape of the number 1. A reference to the many first places that Stefan Everts achieved in his richly filled career (ten world titles 101 GP victories).

"I am very satisfied with the end result," says Stefan Everts. "This bottle really catches the eye. And I also like the link with my victories. In my career I always wanted to be the best. With my gin too."

#### THE IDEA BEHIND THE DESIGN:

 The Nr. 1: Stefan is and still remains the Nr. 1 in motocross. Even though they came close, he is still the record holder with 10 world titles.

• The laurel crown surrounding the logo. A reference to the many

victories Stefan was allowed to achieve in his career.

- The crown with the number 72. The well-known logo of S72 Gin. 72 referring to Stefan's year of birth and the race number he drove in the last years of his career. This number may even only be pinned by Stefan's descendants.
- At the bottom: 10 stars, the 10 world titles won.

 Quote on the right side. Stefan's written life motto. A thinker. It's about always looking ahead and no obstacle is too big to overcome.

Signature of the bottle's initial designer, Troy Lee on the left side.

• At the back, **Stefan's profile with**gold crown. After winning his
10th world title and also the
year of his retirement, he was
celebrated and put a golden crown
on his head. On the same side you

also find **the botanicals** of the S72 Gin 'the Legend' and a 'taste' note that the jury members of an international competition wrote about this gin.

 At the top of the bottle neck: a replica of the former fuel cap.

#### THE FULL STORY

Of the S72 spirits started in 2016. My dad had to deliver something to the Limburg distillery Massy. After a brief chat, he told them I have a strong interest in gin and have quite a collection. The reply he got was that as a distillery, they produce a lot of 'private label' gins in small batches.

My curiosity was piqued. So, I made an appointment and asked if I could make my own gin, as a business gift. And that is where the story begun...

After a few months of 'sampling', I got stuck, I couldn't find the taste I was looking for. My ambition is to create my own flavour, one that you can just pick out from the rest. After a visit to an Italian sponsor, where I was offered a violet-flavoured sweet, the decision was made. The base flavour would be violet,

#### 2019

Further growth of the S72 brand with a new, larger bottle. A bottle that exudes more class.

The end of the year saw the arrival of its big brother, the limited edition 3 litre bottle.

Inspiration for our creative mind, another S72 fire extinguisher and a jerry can were created. Both in very limited quantities.

#### 2020

The tone has been set. August 2020: The new gift boxes arrive. The 'tinned biscuit boxes

from grandma's time' filled with our delicious \$72 Gin, a unique 'copa' glass and a tonic.

**Autumn 2020**: the little brother expands the family: the 35 cl bottle.

A unique collector's item makes its appearance: the S72 Gin Motocross Helmet.

#### 2021

March 2021: The new S72 Vodka bottle is introduced. Same flavour, but a new bottle in the line of the S72 Gin bottle

**April 2021**: Our S72 Gin is awarded a silver medal at the 'London Spirits Competition'. We are consequently extremely proud of this wonderful award.



**Spring 2021:** A brand new gift packaging. The 'S72 Vodka in the Mix', a 50 cl S72 vodka bottle, 3 Red Bulls and a 5 cl pourer.

**August 2021**: Our S72 Vodka is also awarded a medal, A bronze medal was awarded at the World Spirits Trophy 2021.

## CENTAUR SPIRIT

VIOLET REMAINS THE CHARECTERISTIC INGREDIENT IN S72 GIN 'THE LEGEND' FROM MOTOCROSS CHAMPION STEFAN EVERTS

**S72**

is a household name in motocross. Truly everyone knows who it refers to. Belgian Stefan Everts was born in 1972, and to date is the only professional rider to win 10 motocross world titles. A true legend, and a brand. "When I retired from

motocross, the promoter assigned me the rider number 72 forever," explains Everts. "Only my son, Liam, can wear this number at the world championship. I want to expand the S72 brand further. Where? In the world of spirits. My ultimate goal is a wide range of S72 products."

Stefan Everts' passion for spirits was born when meeting another Belgian athlete, Filip Meirhaeghe, during a show on Belgian television. A European and world champion cyclist and mountain bike silver medallist at the Sydney Olympics in 2000, Meirhaeghe is also passionate about spirits and distillation. It was 2012 and after that meeting, Stefan Everts threw himself headfirst into reading up on gin and distillation and expanding his knowledge of spices. "A new world opened up for me!"

After hanging up his racing helmet in 2006, gin was the first thing, second only to his sport, that attracted the interest of the champion. Everts collected gin from all over the world and tasted it, but his vision was to produce a gin that had a unique flavour. It was a very exciting and experimental time.

The S72 spirits project began to take shape in 2016. Stefan's father, Harry, also a four-time world champion, was familiar with the Massy

was looking for a flavour that would clearly distinguish his gin from the rest of the market. During one of his frequent trips to his sponsors in Italy, he tasted a violet sweet. It was a revelation and he decided that his gin would be distinguished by the flavour of violet. Another important flavour would be that of Chinese tea.

In March 2017, the first batch of 200 bottles was produced which Stefan intended to use as a gift for sponsors and friends. The positive feedback received convinced Stefan to launch his gin, which was introduced to the market on 1 June 2017. The new bottle was produced by the Vetro Elite company from Treviso. On the bottle (Vetro Elite's

Denver model) the colour purple stood out, a very significant colour for Stefan Everts, as well as the logo and an image of him in action.

Stefan 2018. launched his violet flavoured vodka 2019 the S72 bottle became wider, and a limited edition 3-litre magnum was introduced. S72 Gin. with an ABV of 43%, is a distilled gin with a profile where the dominant violet sets it apart from the rest of the market. It is a Gin that focuses heavily on floral richness, with clearly distinctive botanical body, that is easy to drink and remember, smooth and elegant.

Everts imagined in his legendary gin the smoothness and style that was a feature of his racing. As a result, it is very important to choose the right tonic for a G&T. The botanical body consists of juniper

distillerv in Houtalen-Helchteren, Belgium, specialists in private label small batches with 110 years of experience. Harry explained to them that Stefan had a passion for spirits and after a short chat and meeting, the project came to life. However, Everts envisioned a product that could be regarded as a business gift for his sponsors.

An ambitious man. Everts



berry, coriander, fresh lime, orange peel, ginger, violet blossom, rowan berry, heath flowers and elderberry,

Stefan Everts loves spending time in the distillery's infusion room – like a kid in a candy shop. That is how a very distinctive limited edition was created, a curious and fashionable version of \$72 Gin flavoured with bubble gum and a 40% ABV. All special releases are packaged in an elegant metal box. In 2021 \$72 Gin won the Silver Medal at the London Spirits Competition.

As part of the project Everts considered the importance of his gin in blending and brought in Belgian bartender Kwinten Ghysens to create some drinks. The signature

recipes of S72 Gin all have names related to motocross jargon.

In his DNA Stefan Everts has the passion needed to reach the top of his every goal, an ambition that seems to be reflected in his last name reminding us of the highest mountain on earth.




